Training of Trainers

CAPACITY BUILDING FOR SELECTED FACILITATORS

In February 2016 KAS together with CHADEMA convened a workshop on capacity building. The overall objective was to create awareness pertaining to the need of political cohesion and leadership in the country after the elections in 2015 in order to foster national development and maintain peace.

At the end of the workshop it was observed that values like political tolerance, political inclusiveness, respect for the electorate and fulfilling campaign promises shall contribute positively to the strengthening of the multiparty democracy and the development of the country.

Since the last general elections in Tanzania in October 2015, CHADEMA under UKAWA has significantly more Members of Parliament (MPs) and councilors than in 2010. Additionally, the 2015 campaigns and elections were very competitive. The UKAWA-factor created a new and wide awareness around CHADEMA.

CHADEMA for the first time in multiparty-history is in the position to manage more than 30 councils. This being a new situation it was thought that facilitators for capacity building of CHADEMA councilors and MPs need more and responsive skills. To this end it was decided to do a training of trainers (ToT) for a selected team of facilitators.
