Scope of the Seminar: The research seminar is aimed at young researchers (doctoral students and postdocs) from the humanities and cultural sciences who work on the historical region of Moldova and the Republic of Moldova. The aim of the seminar is to enable a thematic and methodological interdisciplinary discussion between the participants and the experts invited to the forum, on the one hand, and to facilitate the network between young academics from the Republic of Moldova, Germany and other countries, on the other hand. Current research topics will be presented in the form of brief presentations and then discussed. The research projects will be featured on the website of the International Forum Moldova. Once developed, selected projects can be published in scientific journals.

The research seminar, which will take place on October 16, 2024, is part of the scientific conference that starts with an evening event on October 14.

The **working languages** are German, Romanian and English.

The organizers **will cover the costs** of the seminar, including accommodation, meals and transport.

The application consists of a CV in tabular form, title and short summary of the research topic, copies of the university degree(s), which should be submitted to the convenors in German, Romanian or English by August 31, 2024.
