Since 1970 the Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung awards scholarships to international students from around the world to study and research in Germany. Our scholarship program is aiming at international students and graduates who have acquired a university degree and who intend to complete postgraduate or master studies, doctoral studies or a research stay of at least four semesters at a university in Germany.

- have a university degree and prove above average academic performance,
- are not older than thirty when applying,
- have good knowledge of the German language,
- are actively engaged in voluntary work,
- plan to study a minimum of four semesters at a university in Germany,
- > support democracy, rule of law and human rights.
