Introduction

Ghana has solidified its reputation as the most developed democracy in the West African Subregion with a successful ninth General Presidential and Parliamentary elections under the Fourth Republican Constitution. Though surrounded by countries with records of election issues that had led to military takeovers in some of these countries, Ghana continues to hold the flag of peace under a democracy that offers peace and stability to its citizens to thrive and grow in liberty and freedom.

Despite the few skirmishes recorded in some of the 276 constituencies across the country, especially in the collation centres, the general atmosphere in the December 7th, 2024, election was serene. Thus, Ghana's political maturity ushered in the formal transition process in earnest.

The citizen's expectation from their votes is on now, and the new government is responsible for fulfilling this expectation.

In line with this, the call for proposals is to engage a firm/institution to conduct a nationwide postelection survey on their voting decisions and expectations of voters who went to the polls, which may include those who abstained from voting. A final post-election report will be launched to help shape policy for Ghana's growth and development and the well-being of the citizens.

Eligibilities

- 1. Must be a legally Registered Company in Ghana with a focus on research and action policy development.
- 2. Demonstrate Institutional capacity in undertaking action research and surveys.
- 3. Have requisite staff with a strong background in data collection and reporting.

Selection Criteria

A committee will evaluate the technical proposals received from institutions and score them independently. After that, the financial proposal will also be evaluated to determine the selected Institution.

We are not obliged to award any Institution on submission of the proposal.
